
If a knife is properly cared for it will give longer and more satisfactory service. Instruct your customers in the correct care of their knives. They'll appreciate this added service.

Sharpening


This is the only correct method—read it carefully.

1 Oil the stone so top is fairly moist.


2 Lay blade edge on stone. Raise back of blade about $\frac{1}{8}$ " above stone.



3 Sharpen against the edge (as if cutting into the stone)...drawing the blade toward you off the stone at the same time.




4 On alternate strokes sharpen other side of edge by reversing this operation.
Clean the stone after use.



Oiling

The joints of a knife need oil just like a machine. Clean out the dirt, then put a drop of light oil at each joint. Work the oil in by moving the blade back and forth.



Wiping

To prevent stain or rust, wipe knives clean after contact with moisture or perspiration. Polish the brass and nickel silver with a little silver polish.

THE CARE OF SAMPLES

Uniform arrangement of well-made, well-kept pocket knives starts sales on the way. Here's how to keep your knives and display in tip-top condition.



1. Keep a wiping cloth and a small can of oil with your display.
2. See that all knives are wiped clean after each handling.
3. Every month or two clean off display case window, panel and knives. At the same time rub up the nickel silver and brass of display samples to a bright, shiny finish.
4. Your clerks should all know how to properly sharpen a knife, as per instructions on the back of display case and above.

MR. DEALER

HOW **YOU** CAN SELL MORE POCKET KNIVES



1. KEEP AN ADEQUATE STOCK

Stock all salable patterns (larger quantities of the fast sellers). When a customer wants a certain knife—you have it.

2. KEEP SAMPLES CLEAN

Bright and shiny display samples help to sell knives. Make your knives look worth your selling price.

3. DISPLAY IN GOOD, LIGHTED POSITION

Catch extra "impulse sales" by placing the display in a "Traffic" position. The wrapping counter or near cash register is a good spot.

4. USE PROMOTION MATERIAL

This starts sales and ties into Camillus National Consumer Advertising. It's a good reminder to customers who miss seeing your knife display.

5. DISPLAY IN WINDOW

Every little while a mass window display of knives will help establish your store as cutlery headquarters. A card or a few knives on stands should be in every possible window display. Tie into other feature windows—pruning knife with gardening; camp knife and fishing knife with outdoor, hunting or fishing window; gift knives at Christmas.

6. NEWSPAPER ADS

Work Camillus Knives into your regular newspaper ads. This reminder advertising pays off.

7. TIE POCKET KNIVES INTO OTHER SALES THAT ARE RELATED

#1 Pruning knife to garden equipment.

#72 Whittler knife to shop and tools.

#99 Camp knife to outdoor supplies.

#5 Fisherman's knife to fishing equipment.

#20 Skinning knife to hunting and trapper equipment and so forth.
