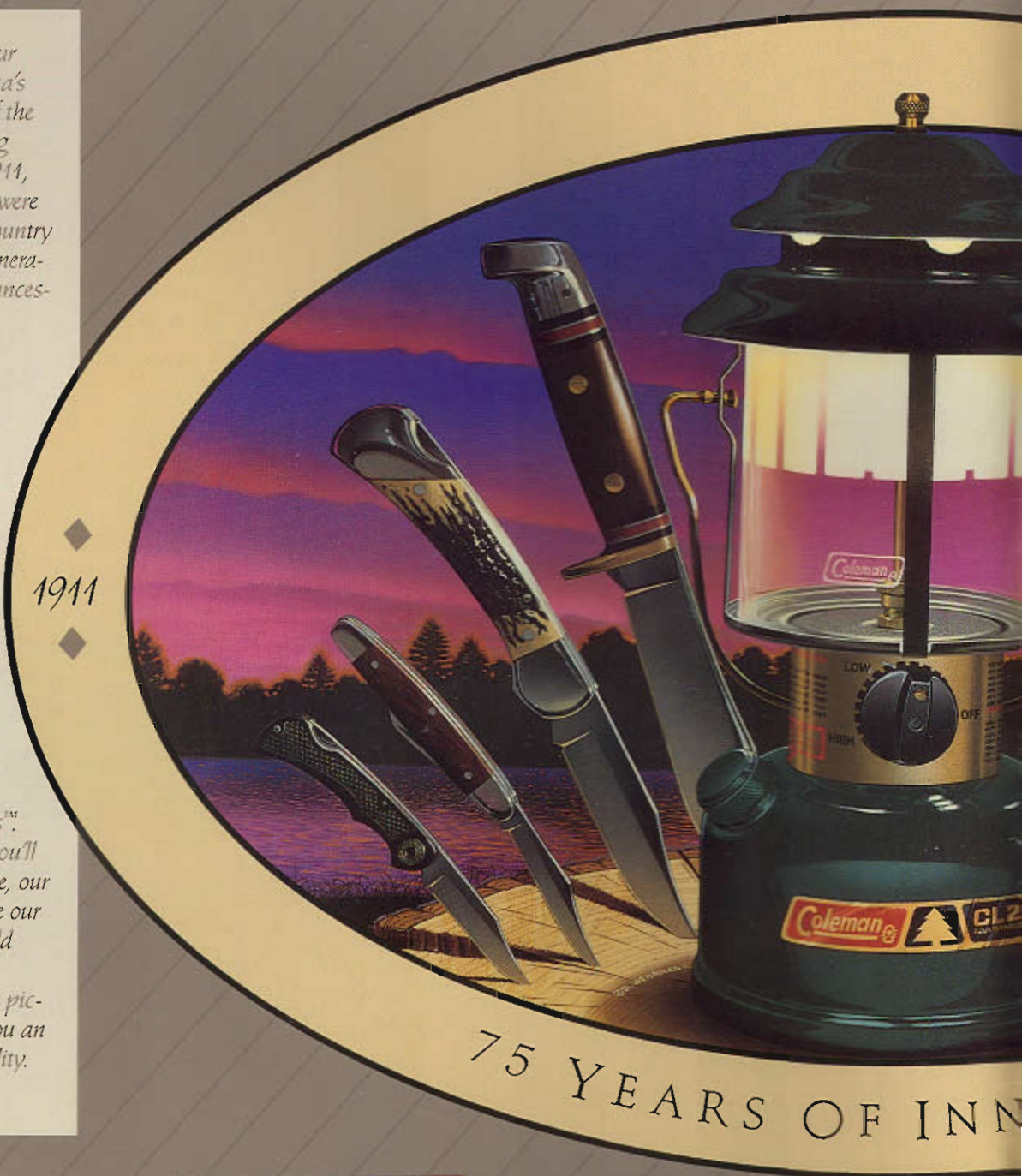

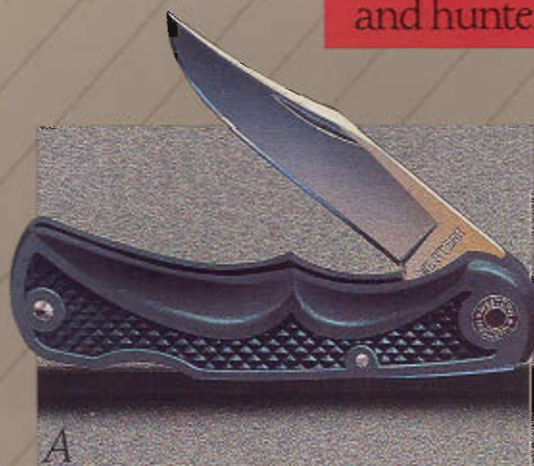

And they're warranted to last a century. Each has satin-finished 440A stainless steel blades and rockers, nickel-silver bolsters for added strength and good looks, and form-fitting handles for a better grip, superior knife control.

A. The 521 Westlock is one of our small-sized knives with resin-impregnated hardwood handles; they're built to take a lifetime of hard use. This knife has a practical 2½" flat-ground drop-point blade.

B. The 522 is virtually identical to the 521 except it features a classic 2½" clip blade. Like all our Westlocks, these knives come with molded top-grain leather belt sheaths.

C. & D. The 532 and 534 are our two mid-sized Westlocks. For those who prefer the looks and performance of a drop point, there's our 532. The 534 has a uniquely shaped clip blade. Both blades are fully flat ground. Both knives come with sheaths.

E. & F. The 541, with its wood handle, and the 542, with its durable Delrin® "staghorn" handle are our largest lock-blades. Both have high saber-ground 3½" stainless clip blades for lasting rust-free performance. Both also have stylish nickel-silver ovals on one side for personalization. Both are available with black sheaths (standard) or brown (optional, on request).

H. The 511 "Nugget" has hardwood handles and a nickel-silver oval that's just right for the engraving of your initials. Or someone else's, as a gift. Every Shortcut knife is available in a handsome gray felt-covered jewelry case; you only have to supply the giftwrap and a bow. Shortcuts are also available

in convenient, hangable packaging for the first time in '86.

I. The 513 Shortcut just may be our most stylish knife of all. It has real turquoise inlay, nickel silver bolsters and pins, solid brass scales, and resin-impregnated hardwood handles. And the same 2 1/2" stainless clip blade common to all our Shortcuts.

J. The 512 has solid German silver handles so it doesn't need scales. Like our 510, it's just 1/4" thick. Inside its oval are found genuine turquoise stones, for a classic "western" touch. There are no other lock-blades made that "walk and talk" like our Shortcuts; our knives "dance and sing."

K. The 381 nail knife is all stainless, super thin, light, and only 3" long. Its satin-finished handle invites engraving or custom etching. And its nail-file blade comes with a cuticle point.

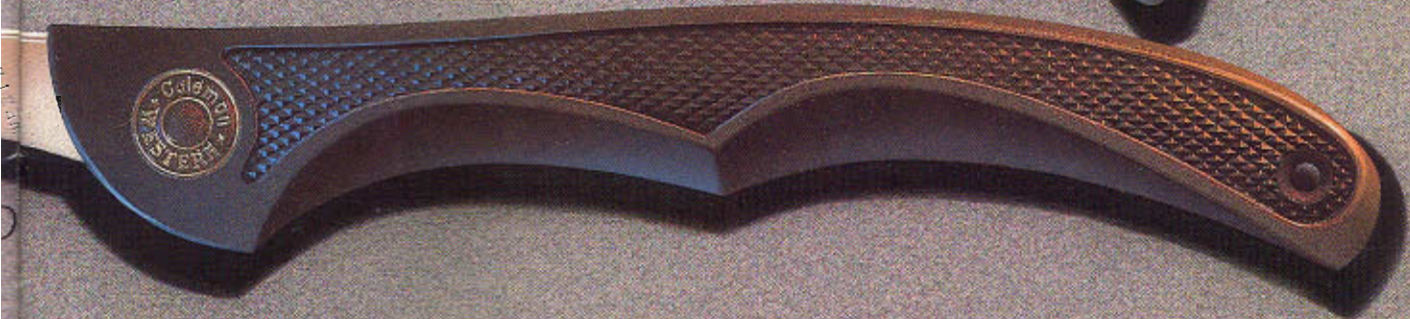

Seems as though every knifemaker in the country has jumped onto the "survival" bandwagon, but only a few make survival knives tough enough to stake your life on.

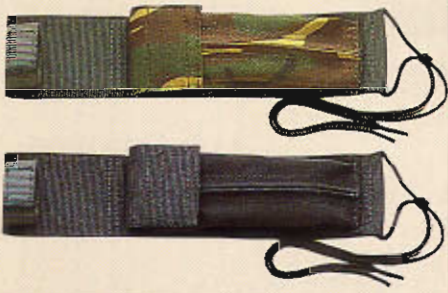
You can bet the two Western® survival knives you see here will be around for a century of hard use. You have our 100-year full warranty behind it.

These knives are more than virtually indestructible. They have the features that a commando would want on his toughest mission. Like a blued, razor-sharp, saber-ground blade of the finest chrome-vanadium steel. Like a saw that's as tough as nails. And an end-knob that's able to drive 'em.

Some "survival knives" have hollow handles for accessories with a compass on the end knob; we think accessories belong in a sheath's pouch. Our 221 and new 221C knives give you the kind of storage room needed for a compass, matches - even hook, line, and sinkers.

A. The 221C "Camo Survival System" is our newest survival knife. Its reinforced handle is made of Valox®, one of the toughest composite materials made. It's specially scalloped for a better grip and shaped to fit even the biggest lumberjack's mitt. The 221C comes with a rugged fabric sheath with a plastic blade guard/sleeve, a camo-colored zippered front pouch with Velcro® closures, and an olive drab belt loop.

B. Our 221 survival knife got rave reviews wherever it was shown. 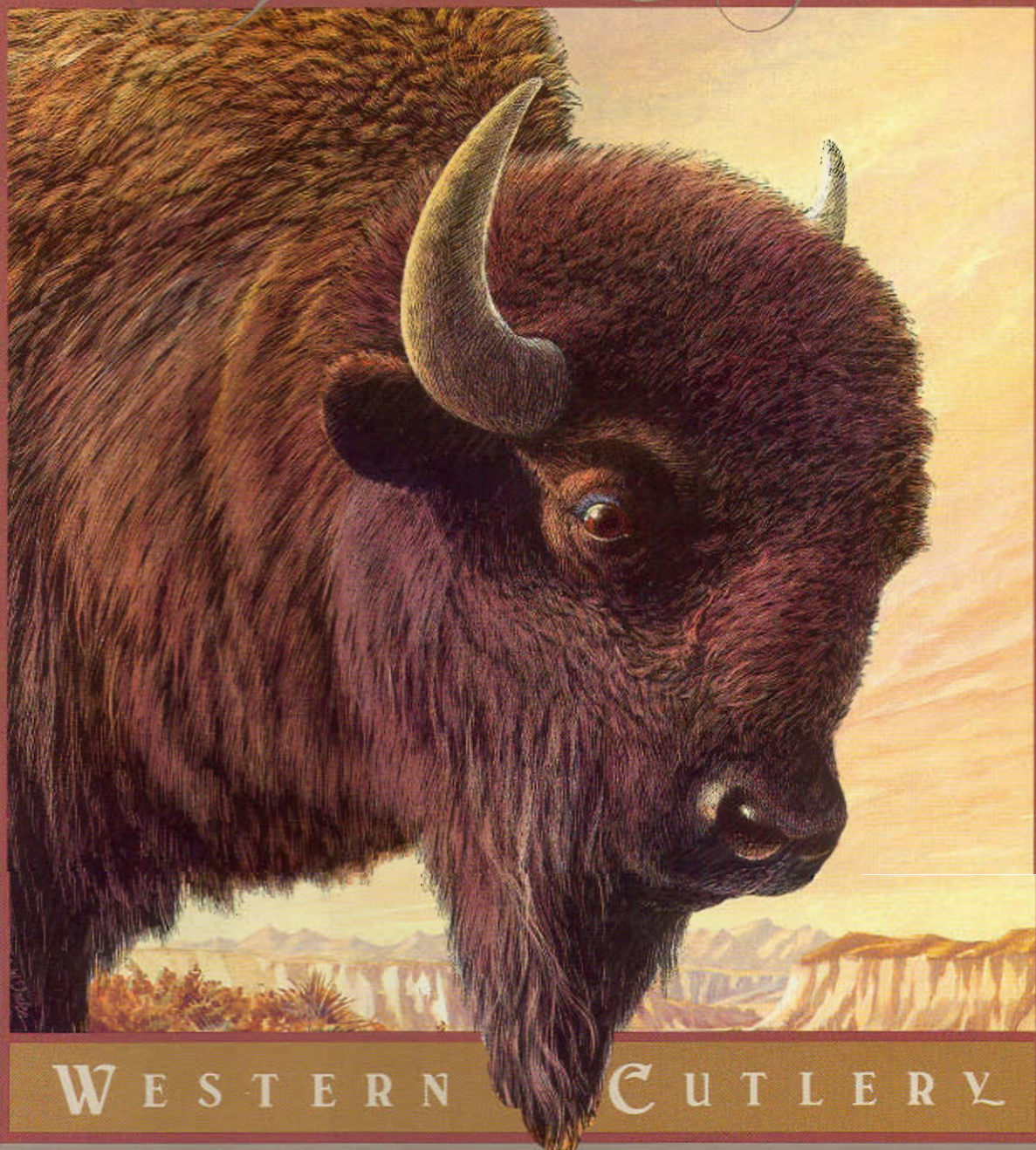

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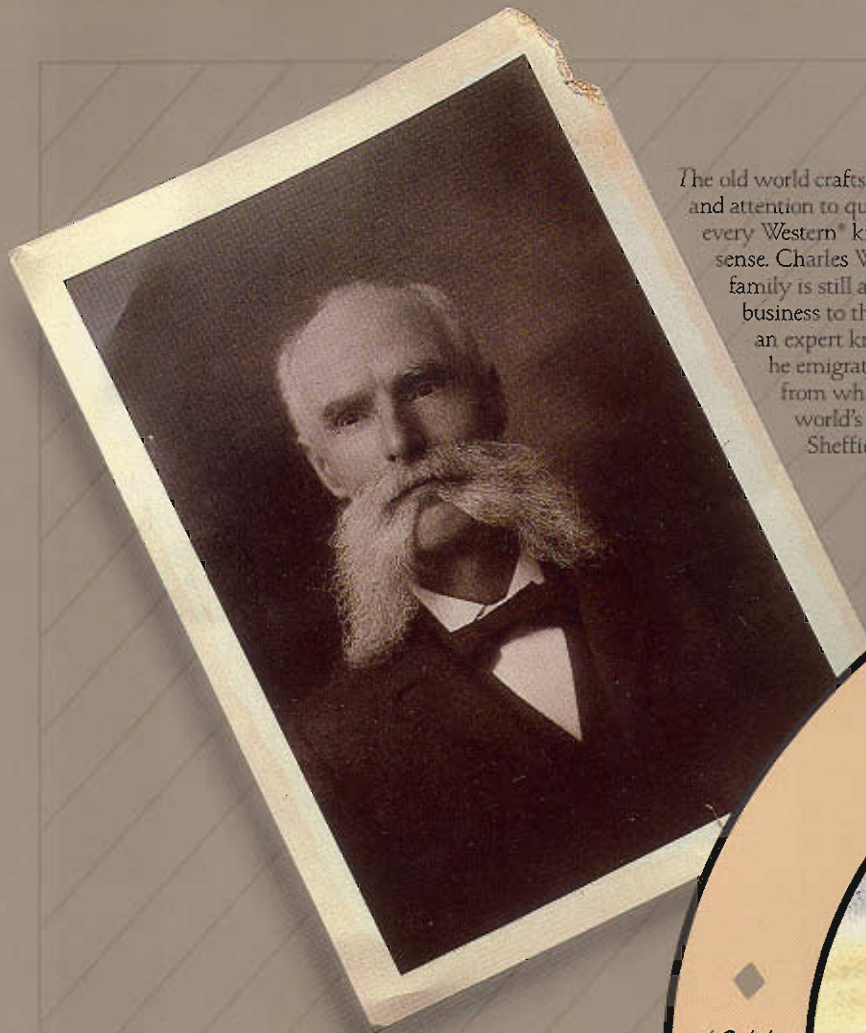

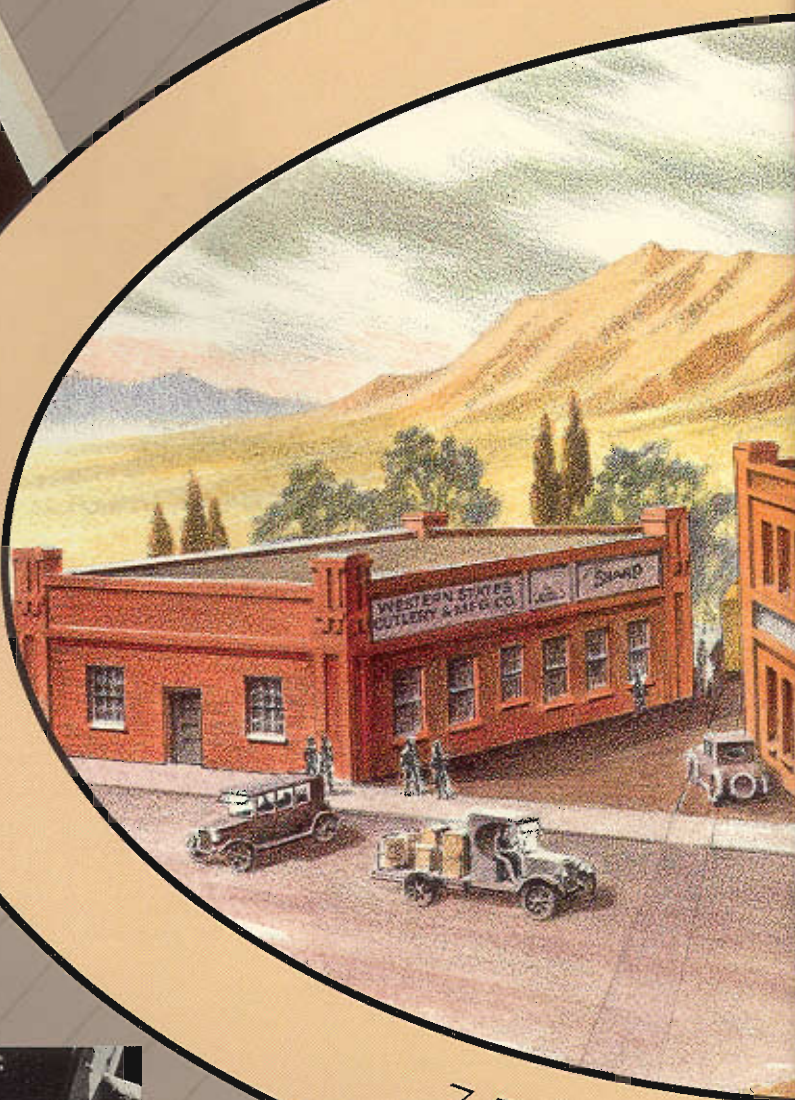

Right from the start, Western knives have been built with quality materials. We use only solid brass in the liners, genuine nickel silver in bolsters and pins, and cutlery-grade alloy steels in blades and springs. Maybe that's why thousands of Western knives built 50 or more years ago are still in use today.





The Westmarks® may be our best custom-quality sheath knives, but they're not so "pretty" that you'll want to keep them forever in a glass case. Far from it. These are also our finest hunting knives and they're up to whatever hard use the toughest outdoorsman can dish out.

Each individually serial-numbered blade is of heavy gauge 440A stainless steel and features our original double-tang construction for optimum strength. Our Westmarks come with triple-thick, hand-crafted molded leather sheaths. Wood presentation cases are also available.

A. The 702 has a high saber-ground 5" blade which makes it the perfect "general purpose" Westmark. Like the rest of the knives in the series, it has a solid brass guard and highly polished aluminum end knob.



B. The distinctive Model 703 has an enlarged choil that lets you safely put one finger and your thumb ahead of the guard for superb knife control. And, when you consider its extra-wide, extra-strong 4½" blade, there's no doubt that the 703 is an ideal working knife for serious big-game hunters.





C. The Model 701, like all our top-of-the-line sheath knives, has a laminated, resin-impregnated hardwood handle that's specially contoured to fit the hand. And last a century. Its saber-ground 5½" blade sports a stylish satin finish.



D. Ask most hunters what first comes to mind when you say "traditional fixed-blade hunting knife" and we'll bet they'll describe the classic, leather-handled Western® L66. Its functional upswept 4½" blade is made of special high-carbon chrome-vanadium steel. Because of the special qualities of leather, this knife features single-tang construction.

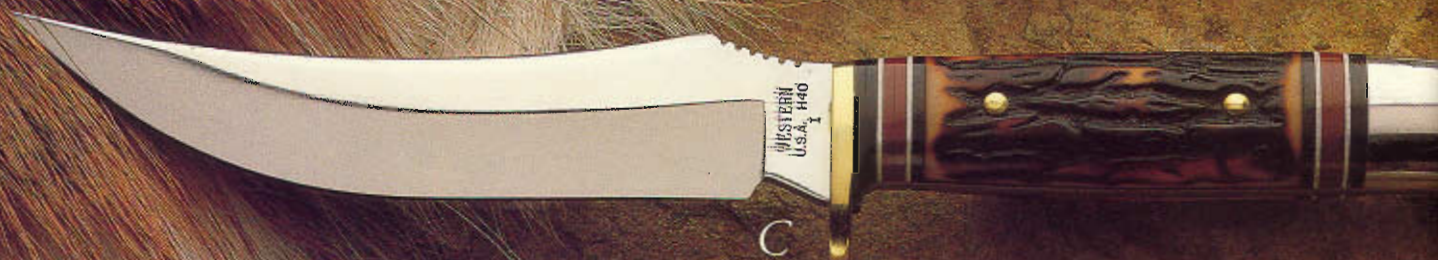


Our double-tang W66 has the classic profile and upswept chrome-vanadium blade of our L66 but features a durable resin-impregnated hardwood handle. A. The 628 is our smallest fixed-blade knife, measuring only 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long overall. That makes it the ideal size for cleaning small game and fish. Thanks to the 628's compact dimensions, it's also a great way to teach your kids responsible knife habits. It has a stag-patterned Delrin® handle and an embossed leather sheath.



B. Our W36 is "heavy duty" all the way. Its extra strong, high-carbon steel blade is flat ground and a full 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long – it's just waiting to be used in the toughest of conditions. Its resin-impregnated wood handle and molded leather sheath can take years of hard use, too.



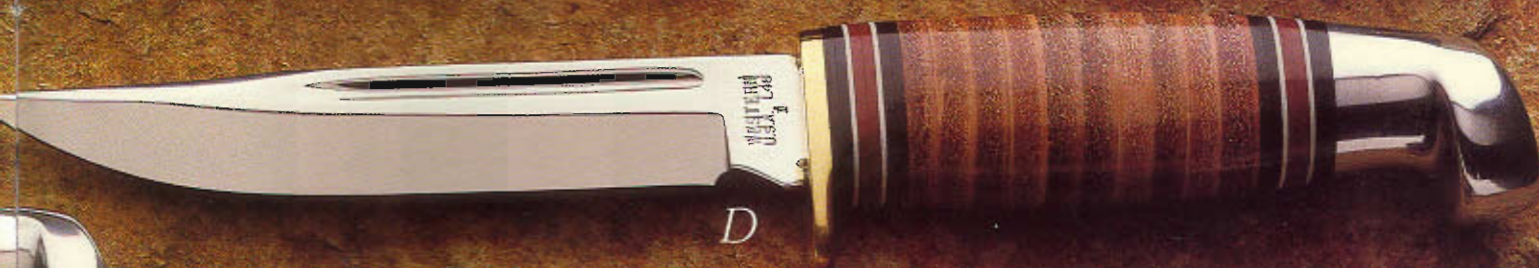
C. The mid-sized H40 is one of our most popular sheath knives. No wonder. Its highly polished chrome-vanadium steel blade is saber-ground and features stylish, yet practical, touches like a gimped thumb rest and a durable Delrin® handle that looks just like genuine staghorn.

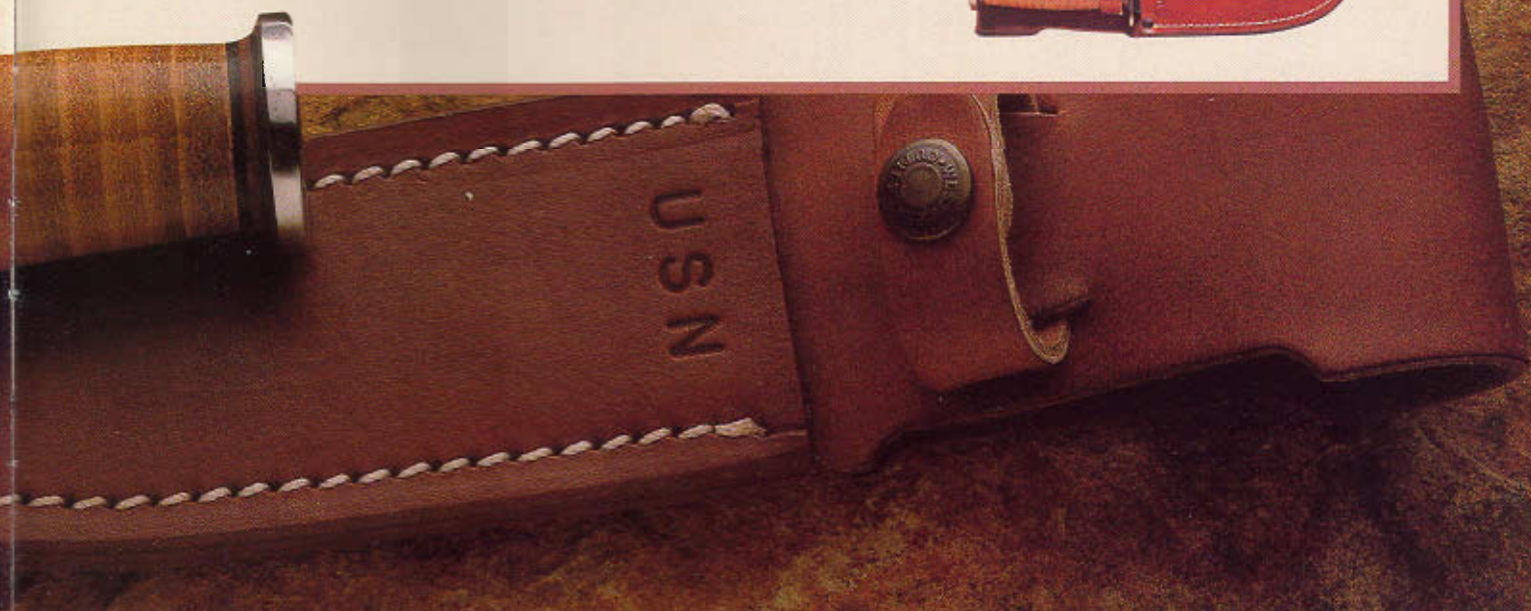

D The Model L48 combines the classic leather handle made famous by our L66 with a practical grooved blade. This mid-sized beauty also features a molded leather sheath, aluminum end-knob, and solid brass guard. Like the L66, it features single-tang construction.

E The W39 has a handsome upswept blade that's similar to our H40, but larger. Both knives now come with better-looking, more durable, molded leather sheaths. The resin-impregnated hardwood handle is complemented with colored fiber washers and a polished end-knob.

E Our L71 "Seabee" knife was introduced last year to rave reviews. It's the virtual carbon-copy of the one we made in record numbers for the Navy's legendary Construction Battalion all through WWII. The L71 has the same leather-washer handle and blued 6½"-long chrome-vanadium steel blade as the original. And a leather sheath appropriately stamped "USN."





A. The W6610 axe-knife combination makes darn good sense to anyone from seasoned woodsman to casual camper. Everything you need fits in one simple, compact sheath. The axe weighs in at just

1 lb. and features a supersharp 2 3/4" cutting edge. The knife which completes the package, our legendary W66, has a saber-ground 4 1/2" blade. Both have matched handles of resin-impregnated hardwood.

B. The W10 axe (below) has a handy leather sheath which is slotted to slip onto any belt. Whether you choose our axe alone or in combination with our W66 knife, you're getting one of the best-looking lightweight axes on the market. And, like every Western knife, it's protected by our exclusive 100-year full warranty.

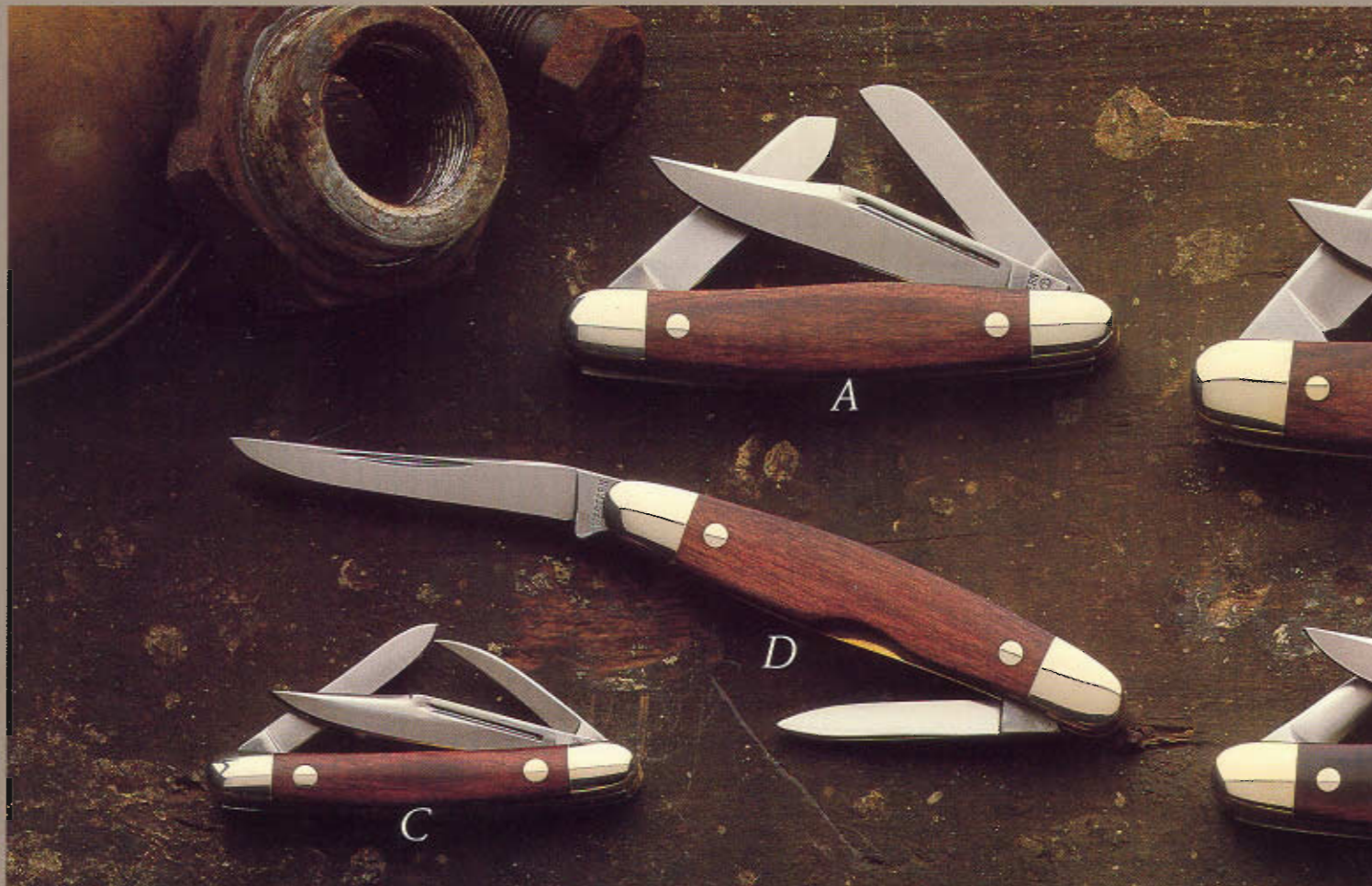
C. Our W49 Bowie knife has classic written all over it. We've been making Bowies since 1964 along the lines of the first one Jim Bowie wielded at the defense of the Alamo 150 years ago. Ours is made to look and work even better though,

thanks to a heavy-gauge 9½" chrome-vanadium steel blade, solid brass guard, and durable resin-impregnated handle. A full-width steel tang extends through the entire handle. An exclusive swing sheath lets this knife be carried with ease, sitting, standing, or riding. A lanyard hole at the base of the sheath is provided to tie it to your leg.

D. Ask for W49W/P and you'll get our Bowie knife with the distinctive hardwood trophy plaque you see below. The display plaque is provided in lieu of a leather sheath.

Over 150 separate hand operations make our current knives as handmade as our first folders. Random samples of our springs are tested for 100,000 openings and closings – ten times the use you'd give them in your lifetime. But that's how we build our pocket knives, because we give them our exclusive 100-year full warranty.

A. Our W658 small stock knife is as full-featured as the best of our folders. It has a master clip blade, spey blade, and a straight-edged sheepfoot blade. All are of cutlery-grade stainless steel, certified shaving sharp right out of the box.

B. The W742 is just the right size for handymen – on the farm, in the tackle-box, wherever. The W742 has a master clip blade, spey blade, and handy sheepfoot blade.

C. The W244, our smallest knife, is big on features. Ideally sized for pocket or purse, this 2 3/8" beauty has stainless steel blades and springs: a master clip blade, pen blade, and surgical lance blade.

D. The W652 is a large pen knife with features that make it our slimmest twin-blade for added comfort in your front pocket. Its stainless steel blades, hinged at opposite ends, are operated by a common stainless spring.

E. The W657 features superb clip and spey blades, plus a very useful leather punch. All blades are made of rugged, easy-to-sharpen 440A stainless steel. All knives from A to F have resin-impregnated hardwood handles for lasting beauty.



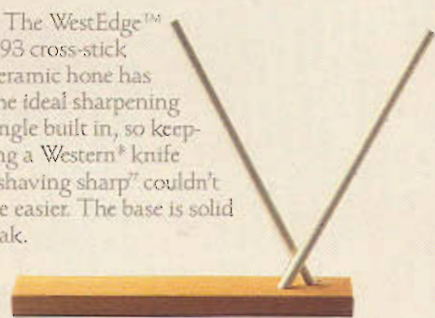


B Our W062 combines a pair of large, hard-working blades with compact dimensions when closed. Each blade is as long as those of many sheath knives. Bolsters and pins on all our pockets are of nickel silver; liners are of solid brass. A nickel silver oval is provided for etching your initials.



E Our Model 932 knife-saw is made just like a survival knife made for Allied pilots in World War II. The saw blade is cut of quality spring-tempered steel. Both it and the 4½" knife blade have square tangs to keep them open as long as you want them open. The clip blade, made of high-carbon chrome-vanadium steel, has a brass split-scale lock. The handle is made of durable Delrin®. A molded leather belt sheath is standard with both our Model 932 and W062 knives.

The WestEdge™ 993 cross-stick ceramic hone has the ideal sharpening angle built in, so keeping a Western® knife "shaving sharp" couldn't be easier. The base is solid oak.
